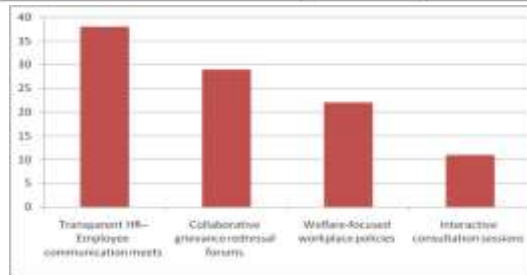




V. RESULTS

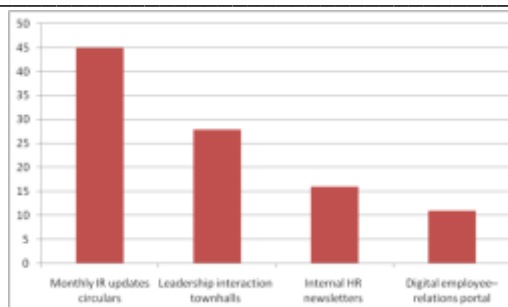

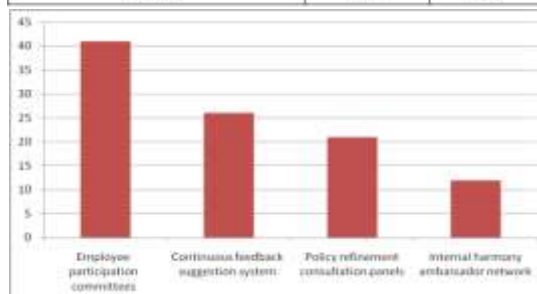

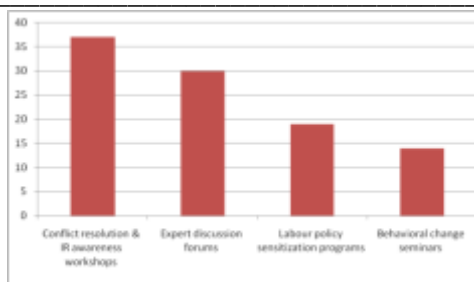

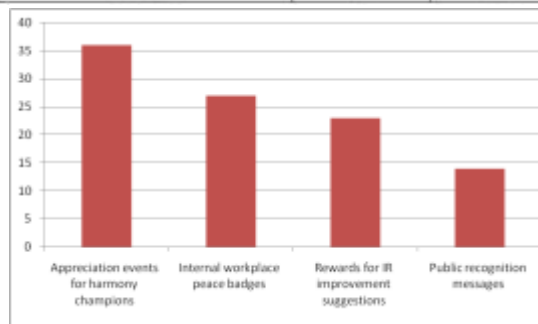
